

Clinical Update / Recent News

FDA Reminder: Evidence-Based changes and care strategies still most important (Thermograpghy)

The field of medicine relies on advancements in technology to drive improvement and change, but the FDA reminds us that changes to clinical practice and patient care strategies should still remain grounded in evidence based medicine. One example that pertains directly to women's health is the use of thermography for breast cancer screening. Thermography generates images showing increased skin temperature associated with increased blood flow, recognizing that dysplastic process require an increase in vasculature and blood flow. Thermography has been approved by the FDA to be used in addition to mammography, but advises against its use in place of mammography for breast cancer screening.
