

Clinical Update - CDC Issues New HPV Recommendation

After a 2 day meeting, the CDC's Advisory Committee on Immunization Practices (ACIP) has put forth a new recommendation that people through age 45 years should discuss getting the HPV vaccine with their medical provider. Continued evidence of the safety of this vaccine plus the benefit of reduction in cervical cancer in people age 27 through 45 prompts this recommendation.

While a smaller number of people between age 27 and 45 may benefit from this vaccine compared to those age 9 through 26, the potential benefit for those individuals cannot be ignored, leading to the endorsement of individualized decision making on the part of the patient and provider rather than a strong recommendation for all individuals in this age group to receive the vaccine.
