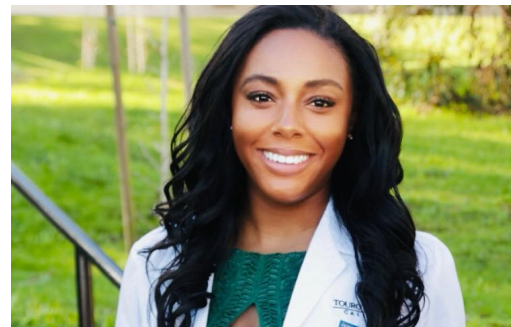

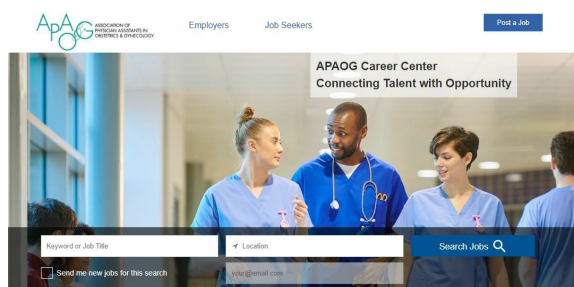
Student Highlight

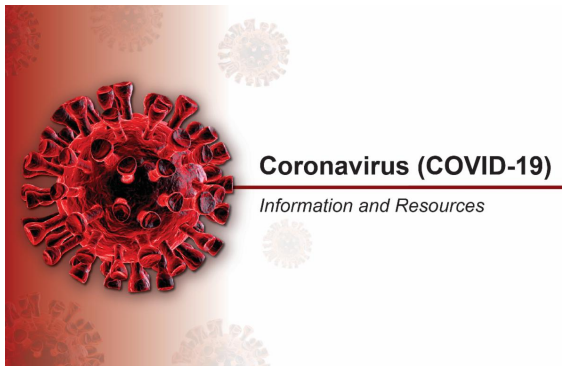

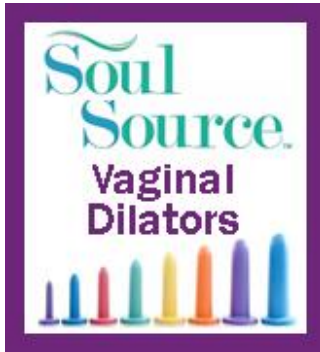

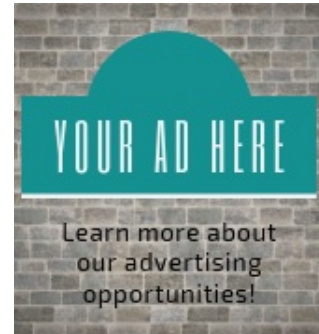
