President's Message

Greetings! APAOG is excited about all the positive changes around us. We are eagerly anticipating our virtual conference on the much-needed topic of disparities in women's health. We know there are huge disparities for women, particularly women of color. CDC data show that black women are 3 to 4 times more likely to die from pregnancy-related causes including cardiac illness, postpartum hemorrhage, pulmonary embolism, and hypertensive disorders. PAs are trained to manage these conditions and can help adequately address them.



Thankfully, with the support from the PAs for Global Health, the African Heritage PA Caucus, PAs for Latino Health, and the Society for PAs in Pediatrics, APAOG has drafted a policy paper regarding disparities in maternal mortality, which the 2021 House of Delegates accepted! We also proudly supported policy amendments by the Commission on the Health of the Public on "Access to Prenatal Care," "Support for Promotion of Safesex Practices and Interventions to Prevent Sexually Transmitted Infections", "Breastfeeding," and Cannabinoid use in Pregnancy and Breastfeeding."

APAOG is also working on a robust plan to address inequities for PAs wanting to enter OBGYN. PAs are medically trained, closely follow ACOG resident training guidelines, and are nimble enough to pivot and solve the disparities and shortages in obstetrics and gynecology. One way to increase PAs in OBGYN is to improve preceptorship opportunities for PA students. Students need examples, guidance, and administrative support. Consider this a preceptorship CALL TO ACTION. Reach out to your local PA program and ask about available clinical preceptor opportunities. We can make the difference.
