Happy Halloween APAOG members!

I have some treats to share for this month. We now have three women's health fellowships with the addition of Arizona's Gynecology Surgery Fellowship at Mayo Clinic and Atrium Health. We now have more options to obtain more specialty-specific care in OBGYN and increase our job opportunities and recognition. Brava to the program directors! Here at APAOG we are gearing up for our *in-person* annual conference in July 2023 planned to



take place in Milwaukee, Wisconsin. We heard your feedback and will make it a fully interactive, hands-on experience to gain the skills you need to succeed. If you have any ideas, send them to apaog@badgerbay.co so we can try to include them. Also, a call for presenters will be coming out soon so consider sharing your expertise.

Additional activities going on at APAOG include building our task force on *Access to Reproductive Care* (ARC) and our task force on *Maternal Immunization (MI)* with the hopes of creating a clinical consensus manuscript, clinical infographics, and patient education material. Our next ARC meeting is scheduled for November 8th! We have also participated in several external committees including <u>Free the Pill</u> which supports overthe-counter progesterone pills for contraception. The <u>FDA Advisory Committee</u> will convene on November 18th, 2022 (OPILL (norgestrel) Tablet, 0.075 mg). Interestingly, the FDA Advisory Committee convened on October 17-19 to discuss the withdrawal of Makena for the prevention of preterm birth due to the lack of efficacy. Their final decision should be available in November.

I will conclude with encouragement to participate in our many educational platforms including webinars, podcasts, and the Artemis journal. Our last webinar showcased a new opportunity with the NIH All of US research team to become a researcher, use their dataset to answer clinical questions, and have the opportunity to publish. We encourage you to be the change you want to see and we will support you along the way.
