

Topic: An STI Update: Improving Upon Our Prior Knowledge of Sexually Transmitted Infections

Final Recommendation Statement: Screening for Ovarian Cancer

The U.S. Preventive Services Task Force released today a final recommendation statement on screening for ovarian cancer. The Task Force found the harms of screening to outweigh the benefits and recommends against screening for ovarian cancer in women without signs or symptoms.
