HPV Testing Accuracy

The results of a recent randomized clinical trial conclude that high risk HPV testing is more sensitive and accurate than cytology at detecting cervical dysplasia/precancerous cervical lesions. The study included women age 30-59, and the current

Learn more about advertising opportunities! recommendations for cervical cancer screening for this age group are cytology plus HPV testing every 5 years or cytology alone every 3 years. It is important to note that the Hybrid Capture 2 HPV DNA test was utilized in the study. HPV DNA testing is currently FDA approved for primary screening for women starting at age 25. This new evidence should generate additional research and may results in a future changes to the cervical cancer screening guidelines. According to the article "further research is needed to understand long-term clinical outcomes as well as cost-effectiveness" and perhaps the role of HPV mRNA testing will be studied as well.
