


Managing Menopause

Speaker: Rachel Ditoro, MSPAS, PA-C

Description:

Menopause and aging are associated with negative changes to the brain, skeletal, cardiovascular and urogenital



Menopausal hormone therapy (MHT) is the most effective intervention for the management of these symptoms, however following the Women's Health Initiative (WHI) study in 2002 use of MHT declined sharply. Review of later subgroup analysis and follow-up phase evaluation now supports use of MHT in selected menopausal women for relief of these symptoms. Non-hormonal therapies are also available, as well as over-the-counter supplements for symptom relief, and should be explored in order to fully counsel patients about all of their options.

- Determine appropriate use of menopausal hormone therapy (MHT) within select patient populations.
- Describe non-hormonal therapies for the alleviation of menopausal symptoms.

Clinical Update

USPSTF Publishes Updated Cervical Cancer Screening Recommendations

The USPSTF published updated recommendations for cervical cancer screening in the August 21st issue of JAMA. ASCCP commended the USPSTF for its support of multiple screening options for women. The new recommendations support that use of

primary hrHPV testing alone for screening in women age 30-65yo. More specifically, the USPSTF supports the use of cytology alone every 3 years, hrHPV testing alone every 5 years, or cotesting every 5 years for this population.

The article goes on to say that switching from cytology alone to hrHPV testing alone at age 30yo offers similar cancer reducing benefits as making the same switch at age 25yo, but results in fewer colposcopies. They continue to support the use of cytology alone every 3 years in women age 21-29yo, and no cervical cancer screening in women <21yo, >65yo, or following hysterectomy where the cervix has been removed and there is no history of high grade cervical dysplasia or cervical cancer.
