


APAOG Awards Now Open - Nominations Due March 15, 2017

Clinical Updates

"There is growing support among experts for HPV testing to replace or supplement pap tests as the primary method for cervical cancer screening. An article highlighting this support can be accessed here. The 2012 Consensus Report on cervical cancer screening guidelines, as well as the 2015 report for the use of HPV testing as a primary cervical cancer screening tool, can be accessed on the ASCCP website under guidelines. On February 14, 2017, the ASCCP

released a *Choosing Wisely* publication that can help clinicians sort out the need and best method for cervical cancer screening in special situations. This piece can be accessed <u>here</u>.

"A review of 204 observational studies found that there is strong evidence supporting a link between adiposity and numerous primary cancers, including endometrial, ovarian, and postmenopausal breast cancer. Their review supports linkages between the following; endometrial cancer and increased waist to hip ratio, postmenopausal breast cancer and weight gain, and ovarian cancer and obesity. Other linked cancers were esophageal, multiple myeloma, stomach, colon, rectum, biliary tree, pancreas, and kidney. A summary of their evidence can be found at the following link. The full article was published in *BMJ* on February 28, 2017 and can be accessed by the following link."
